FAQ

1) Allocation of places - when will my child receive a place at the childcare centre?

Free places are allocated by the individual childcare centre, not by the Studierendenwerk München Oberbayern. As soon as there is a place free for your child, the facility's management will get in touch with you.

2) Who can register for the waiting list?

Only students and university staff can have their name put on the waiting list. External applicants have the possibility to register via the kita finder:

3) How old does my child need to be to register for the waiting list?

As soon as your child is born, your name can be added to the waiting list.

4) How can I register my child for the waiting list?

Students can register online. Please note that students do not receive an email confirming their registration.

University staff need to fill in a registration form and send it to the department "Studying with a Child".

5) Which of the childcare centres only accept families who live in Munich?

The childcare centres Bim Bam Bino, Herzerl, Olydorfspatzen, Meki & Murmele and Uni-Kleckse are only authorised to accept families who live in Munich.

6) Time of admission

Depending on whether or not there are any places available in a childcare centre, children can also be admitted once the year has started (not only at the beginning of a new school year in the childcare centre).

7) How old does my child need to be for admission?

Childcare centre 0 – 3 years, kindergarten 3 – 6 years.

8) Information events in the childcare centres

The childcare centres' information events take place once each semester. The exact dates can be found under the heading "Information Events".

Parents whose children are already on the waiting list will be sent an invitation by email roughly two weeks before the information event is due to take place.
